How to Play Gator Bingo:

1. If you would like to play with us live on Zoom: register at:

After registering, you will receive an email with a link special for you to join the call. This is going to help us make sure we have room for everyone who wants to play. If we reach our registration maximum, we will schedule a second call.

2. Download a copy of the Gator Bingo cards at:

or pick up some pre-printed cards at the front of the school between 9 AM and 2 PM on Friday.

3. If playing on Zoom:

Gather some small objects to use as game makers, or if you have printed out enough cards for your whole family to use multiple times, you can also use a pencil or pen to keep track. Have each member select one card per round to keep up with.

At 7 pm on Friday, September 18th, join using the call using the Zoom link emailed to you when you registered. Please remember all the basic Zoom etiquette being used for classes as you join the call.

If playing on your own:

Each set of cards, also includes a sheet of game pieces. Cut out the game pieces and play a round by placing the pieces in a bowl or box and randomly draw them out to play.

4. To win: players must fill up their card with 5 in a row, horizontally, vertically or diagonally.
